Sermon Notes

Grace Glossary:

Lent: which means "spring," is the 40-day season preceding Easter when we are called to reconsider our lives in light of Jesus' suffering and death on our behalf.

Tempt, Test, Try: is the same word, with context determining the meaning. God may test and try our faith to purify and strengthen it, while Satan tempts us to act faithlessly. Both God and Satan may be active in the same occasion to bring about their separate ends.

"Tested, Tempted, Tried, and True"
Luke 4:1-13 and Hebrews 4:12-17

- 1) Trials are tests God uses to prove our faith, and Satan uses to devour it.
- 2) Trials raise the essential question, "Who will rule our hearts?"
 - A) Satan, who exploits our human weakness to deceive us into acting faithlessly.
 - B) Jesus Christ, our sympathetic High Priest and Model.
